Biographical Sketch:

Tom Harpur (1929-2017) was an Anglican minister, educator, journalist and writer. After ordaining in 1956, Harpur served as a parish minister in Ontario from 1957-1964. In 1964, he was hired as a professor of the New Testament at the University of Toronto and he held this position until 1971 when he made the decision to become a journalist. He was the Toronto Star's religion editor until 1984 and continued to write columns on religion for the Toronto Star and other media outlets. Harpur also wrote several books including Harpur's Heaven and Hell (1983), Communicating the Good News Today (1987), Always on Sunday (1988), Life After Death (1991), For Christ's Sake (1993), Harpur vs. Hancock (1994), Finding the Still Point (2002) and The Pagan Christ (2004), which was later adapted into a documentary. The Pagan Christ was a national bestseller and led Harpur to write the sequel, Water into Wine (2007). Several of Harpur's books became the basis for television series which aired on Vision TV and included Harpur's Heaven and Hell, Harpur vs. Hancock, Life After Death and the Uncommon Touch.

Scope and Content:

Papers consist of records created and acquired by Tom Harpur in the course of his career as a journalist and writer. Included are his columns for the Toronto Star and other media outlets; short stories and other writing that he did along with records related to his books; research materials for the Pagan Christ; various television series and documentaries which he hosted and were based on his books; correspondence with his readers, publishers, and colleagues; and interviews and other records relating to publicity. Also included is a small amount of personal material and photographs, pertaining to his education and early career. Some published materials were received as part of the donation but were either not retained or catalogued separately. A list of these books is included as an appendix to this finding aid for reference purposes.

Series 1: Journalism

Scope and Content: Series consists of records relating to Harpur's career as a journalist – first as religion editor for the Toronto Star, then as a freelance journalist writing a weekly column for the Toronto Star and for various other newspapers and magazines. Harpur's columns address a variety of religious and ethical topics. Selections of his columns were published in three collections "Always on Sunday" (1988), "God Help Us" (1992) and "Living Waters" (2006). Reviews of the first two published collections as well as correspondence from readers about the collections are included. The series also includes a recording made by Tom Harpur when he traveled to Calcutta as the Toronto Star's religion editor to meet Mother Teresa.

Series 2: Short Stories and Records Relating to Books

Scope and Content: Series consists of records relating to Tom Harpur's writing. Included are some early short stories that he wrote as well as files of records relating to his various books including the two children's books that he wrote. Files contain reviews, research notes, author's contracts and promotional and publicity materials such as articles about his books. Several files relate to Harpur's most successful book the Pagan Christ and include reviews, articles and a variety of promotional materials. Also included are a proposal for a book about evolution, research notes and royalty statements.

Series 3: The Pagan Christ Research Materials

Scope and content: Series consists of reference materials consulted by Harpur in the course of writing his book “The Pagan Christ,” as well as subject files relating to his research and notes that he made. Included among the reference materials are essays, journal articles, chapters of books, encyclopedia entries, printouts of websites and other sources that he consulted. A significant amount of the material comes from American theosophist Alvin Boyd Kuhn, a

proponent of the Christ-myth theory, who Harpur referenced extensively in his book. Also included are materials from Gerald Massey and others. While most of the material pre-dates the publication of *The Pagan Christ*, there is also material which Harpur consulted after the publication of the book, reflecting his continued interest in the topic which culminated in the publication of a sequel to *The Pagan Christ* – *Water into Wine*. Many of the materials include notes and annotations made by Harpur during his research. Most of the dates recorded in this finding aid reflect original dates of publication and not dates of reproduction as in most cases, dates of reproduction are unknown.

Series 4: Television Series and Documentaries

Scope and Content: Series consists of recordings of television programs, mini-series and documentaries which were hosted by Tom Harpur, based on his books or which included him as a guest. Included are videocassettes with episodes of Harpur's Heaven and Hell (which aired for three seasons from 1992 to 1994), Harpur vs. Hancock (which aired from 1993 to 1999), Life After Death (which aired for 10 episodes in 1996) and the Uncommon Touch (which aired in

1999). Programs were produced by Sleeping Giants Productions and aired on Vision TV. Also included is the documentary The Pagan Christ (which the CBC aired in December 2007) as well as documentaries and television series episodes which featured Tom Harpur as a guest.

Series 5: Professional Correspondence

Scope and Content: Series consists of correspondence sent and received by Tom Harpur over the course of his career as a journalist and writer. Included are printed e-mails, cards and letters that he received from readers, colleagues who were interested in collaborating with him, friends, editors of newspapers and publishers. Some correspondence are accompanied by attachments which were also printed and filed by Harpur.

In the correspondence received by Harpur from readers (both electronically and by post), readers comment on the impact that his writing had on their lives, share stories about events in their lives, describe their personal struggles, ask for Harpur's advice, ask questions which arose out of their reading of his work, recommend additional resources which they thought Harpur may enjoy and argue against aspects of his point of view. Some correspondents react to particular articles written by Harpur, commenting on their views of the issue and sometimes arguing against Harpur's point of view.

Correspondence with colleagues includes requests for interviews, discussions about Harpur's arguments and the sources he used, discussions about the logistics of projects they were embarking on and thank you letters for his participation in various events and projects. Also included in the series are files of correspondence with particular individuals with whom Harpur had extensive dialogues including Karl Luckert, Larry Marshall, Rick Mannell, Harpur's editors at Thomas Allen Publishers and the publisher and editor at the Toronto Star. Correspondence with these individuals can also be found in the general correspondence files. Majority of the correspondence was kept in chronological order by Harpur and this arrangement has been maintained.

Scope and Content: Series consists of records relating to the publicity and promotion of Tom Harpur's work, especially his books.
